T-Ball begins on **June 14th, 2021** and will run 5 Monday nights through July 19th (NO Games July 5th).

Location of playing fields – Games will be played on the south side of the Ellsworth middle school on the middle school football field which is right across the street from the middle school.

Ellsworth Funsters T-Ball is: A beginning level program designed for children ages 4 to Kindergarten age (at least 4 years old or within 2 months of being 4 - no exceptions) through kindergarten, 1st graders are too old for t-ball and will need to join baseball or softball. T-Ball players hit a ball off a tee with all players batting each inning, when all runners will "score" including the last batter. All players will play in the field with no particular set rotation or positions. This beginning level program is designed to introduce the game of baseball. Children that have completed Kindergarten are encouraged to move up to baseball or softball. For baseball or softball go to -

Protocol for Covid-19 Safety for Summer 2021

The Ellsworth Funsters Youth T-ball Program is for Ellsworth residents ages 4 through Kindergarten. All activities will be held outdoors and weather permitting. The program consists of 5 Monday nights during the summer months (5 nights between June 14th and July 19th). Games are for fun and are not competitive. Please see below for the Covid guidelines we will be following. We have put together these safety measures this year based on the Public Health and CDC Guidelines and made a few changes to our regular program. Please see below for specific safety measures.

Covid Specific Protocol for Players and Coaches

- Hand Sanitizer will be available for youth/adults/coaches/helpers at all times.
- Teams will be limited in size and helpers will be available to keep kids distanced and help in wiping down equipment.
- Unless vaccinated, coaches and helpers will be encourage to have a mask with them and use it anytime they are level and in close distance with youth (like helping them bat etc.) unless they provide proof of full vaccination.
- If required to do so, Coaches/Funsters will keep a log of players for each night of play.
- Bats will be sanitized.
- Players will not be allowed to share gloves/mitts.
- Coaches will work to ensure no handshakes at end of game or high fives during games and a “wave” will be used at the end of game to salute opposing team, no handshakes.

Parents are being given the same guidelines as school about keeping players home who are sick. Anyone experiencing symptoms of Covid should not attend play nights.

Players will maintain social distancing whenever possible. This will reduce the likelihood of transmission and reduce the risk of being identified as a close contact in the event of a case is identified within a teammate.

If a player/coach/helper tests positive during the 5 week season they must notify the Funsters T-Ball Directors and/or team coach.

Covid Specific Protocol for Spectators at Outdoor Ellsworth Funsters Summer T-Ball 2021

Spectators will be required to sit at least six feet from other spectators not in the same family during games and six feet from players. They will be encouraged to not congregate at the end of games.

Face coverings will be encouraged for spectators but not required.

Spectators and parents will be required to conduct daily symptom assessment for themselves if coming to game nights, and for their child players, and stay home if experiencing any symptoms of COVID or if recently been in close contact with anyone testing positive.

What if a player is sick or exposed.

Players coaches and parents will need to follow the isolation and quarantine guidance on the Pierce County Public Health website at <https://covid-piercecounty-wi.hub.arcgis.com> The guidance will tell you what to do if you have been diagnosed with Covid-19 or have been in close contact with someone with Covid-19.
